Breast Screening at the BCI Sunflower Clinic, Mt Drutt Hospital

- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander women aged 40 and over are recommended to have a breast screen every 2 years.
- It's important to stay healthy for yourself, your family and community.
- If found early, breast cancer is easier to treat and there is an increased chance of survival.
- Screening is free and an appointment takes just 20 minutes. No GP referral required.

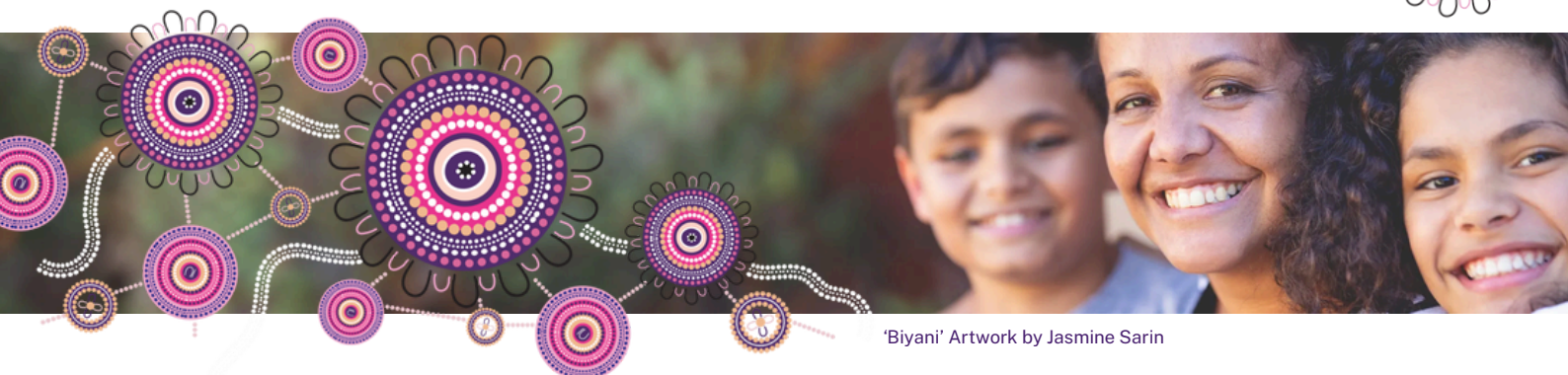

- The National Cervical Screening Program reduces illness and death from cervical cancer.
- Women and people with a cervix aged 25 to 74 years of age are invited to have a Cervical Screening Test every 5 years.
