

Coronavirus (COVID-19) testing in Western Sydney

COVID-19 testing is now available for anyone with symptoms

Seek medical attention if you are experiencing a sore/scratchy throat, cough, fever, shortness of breath or other symptoms such as unusual body aches and pains, change in smell and taste or a runny nose.

You do not need to have travelled overseas or been in contact with someone who has coronavirus. Contact your doctor (GP) or a COVID-19 Testing Clinic, or call 1800 020 080 (24 hours a day/7 days a week).

Where to get tested

COVID-19 tests at a Public Testing Clinic are free of charge for everyone. This includes people without a Medicare Card, such as visitors from overseas and Asylum Seekers.
