

Platforms to Assist You During the Holiday Season

The holiday period is a great time to celebrate and connect with friends and family, but it can also be a stressful time of year if your health is affected. Below we have put together a list of self-access health services available outside of business hours for local Western Sydney residents, without the need of a referral:

- Healthdirect provides health service via telephone on 1800 022 222. If you need to see a doctor, you can also search healthdirect's service finder for a local GP or health service that's open near you.
- Healthy Western Sydney is a free website for community members in Western Sydney allowing you, your carers and families access to a range of health resources. It contains information that's recommended by local health professionals.
- If you're trying to improve your own mental health, or support somebody else with mental health issues, Head to Health provides links to trusted Australian online and phone supports, resources and treatment options.
- Connections Western Sydney Helpline is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, including the festive season. The helpline number is 1300 096 273.
- Mindguide.org.au provides a range of self-help and mental health resources for people wanting to increase their understanding of what they or a family member may be experiencing.
- There are also 24-hour helplines available for other services such as counselling, poisons information centre and alcohol and drug support. You can also follow our Western Sydney After Hours Facebook page for updates on local health services.
